Avenue of the People

The Art on the Town outdoor sculpture gallery has new pieces that are a must see. Eleven groupings have just been installed along Laurel Street from the ferry terminal to the fountain at the center of town. Each piece is sculpted from steel plate and is a depiction of one of our local citizens.
